Central Finance - Functional Overview

S/4HANA system, installed as a side-car, receiving financial accounting transactions via real-time replication from SAP or non-SAP ERP systems with a set of enabling technologies (logging, replication, mapping, digitization, posting, error correction and reconciliation) that allow any enterprise, SAP or not, to start using S/4HANA Finance innovations.

Central Budgeting for Projects Highlights

Value for Users:

Proiect Financial Controller

Motivation / Background

Centralize budget processes in a Central Finance system for projects replicated from one or several source systems.

Solution / Feature

Processes consuming budget in a source system will run a remote budget check against the budget and availability control of a Central Finance System.

Business Benefit

- ✓ Increase efficiency by running budget related processes in a Central Finance system for several source systems, e.g. budget reporting can be run in a Central Finance system and no consolidation of data out of several source system is
- Reduced efforts of Customizing activities for availability control and tolerance limits, as they are maintained centrally and don't have to be maintained in each source system separately.

Central Asset Accounting

Asset Accounting in the SAP system is used for managing and monitoring fixed assets. In Financial Accounting, it serves as a subsidiary ledger to the general ledger, providing detailed information on transactions involving fixed assets.

Central Finance System

Budget Maintenance

- Option 1: if you run asset accounting in your source system, you can replicate the related GL postings into the Central
- Option 2: you do not need to have the asset master data in the source system: you could use projects in the source system which get replicated into the Central Finance System where Asset Accounting is active and to which the projects can be settled (see picture)

- You can run reporting in a Central Finance system and don't have to consolidate data from multiple systems.
- Asset-related closing activities run centrally in a Central Finance system and reduce the complexity of multiple source systems.

 Asset Accounting is part of the S/4HANA Enterprise Management license

 The new intelligent Asset Accounting currently cannot be activated / used in a central finance deployment as it is currently only provided for Public Cloud customers (no EX, PCE, HEC and


- Financial data is already mapped and re-posted in S/4HANA using Central Finance, unlike standalone consolidation solutions that must handle dimensional mappings within the consolidation solution





Centralized plan-versus-actual analysis by replicating plan data	 Improve better decision making in the central finance system by: Collecting plan data from the source systems Adding additional plan figures centrally Enable plan-versus-actual analysis by replicating plan data




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Roadmap for Finance and Accounting
