

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
Introduction

In addition, [Gartner reports](#) that as of Q2 2024, 63% of ECC customers had not yet licensed S/4HANA, reflecting the complexity and hesitation surrounding full-scale migration. Gartner emphasizes that while organizations do not need to migrate now, they must still develop a clear plan—whether they choose to migrate, modernize, or remain on ECC—to avoid increased costs, disruptions, and missed opportunities for innovation.
